#### Safeguarding children

Safeguarding children is everyone's responsibility. It is about protecting children (all people under the age of 18) from maltreatment and harm. All our coaches are DBSchecked.

#### Please note:

- · Children and adults must not change/shower in changing rooms at the same time.
- · Coaches are not permitted to travel with children who are not their own without another adult present.

If you have any concerns with regards to your child, or other children, in relation to safeguarding (for example: safety, harassment, abuse, bullying etc) please contact the Club's Safeguarding Officer, Bill Bolton (bill.bolton@hotmail.co.uk).

If you are not able to be present at the Club during junior training or junior cricket matches, we require that you assign a responsible adult as a Temporary Guardian for your child(ren) for the duration of your absence. We will require this information before the start of every session and before you leave the Club.

In the event that you cannot be contacted you agree to your child(ren) receiving any necessary emergency medical treatment.

You are aware that it is ECB policy that all children/players under the age of 18 wear a helmet with faceguard at all times when playing with a hard ball, either batting, wicket keeping or fielding within 6 yards of the bat, except behind square on the offside. In the event that you do not provide a helmet for your child(ren) you agree to the Club providing one which complies with ECB safety standards.

All other policy documents are displayed in the Clubhouse should you wish to read them.

I/we have read the Club statements regarding, codes of conduct and the Spirit of Cricket, taken from the ECB laws, and agree that I/we will endeavour to abide by them.
